GA FAIRTAX TOUR UPDATE

WASHINGTON, DC - Congressman John Linder (R-Ga.) will tour his home state of Georgia December 13 to promote the FairTax bill, (H.R.2525), a bi-partisan plan for comprehensive tax reform that he has co-sponsored with Democrat Colin Peterson (D-Minn.)

The FairTax would eliminate payroll, inheritance, and estate taxes, corporate and personal income taxes, and dismantle the IRS; replacing them with a flat national sales tax. Workers would be able to bring home their ENTIRE PAYCHECK, each and every payday.
